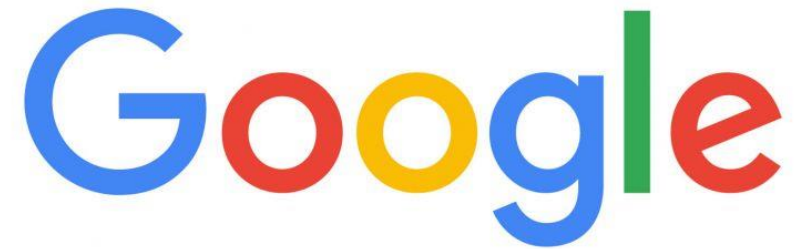

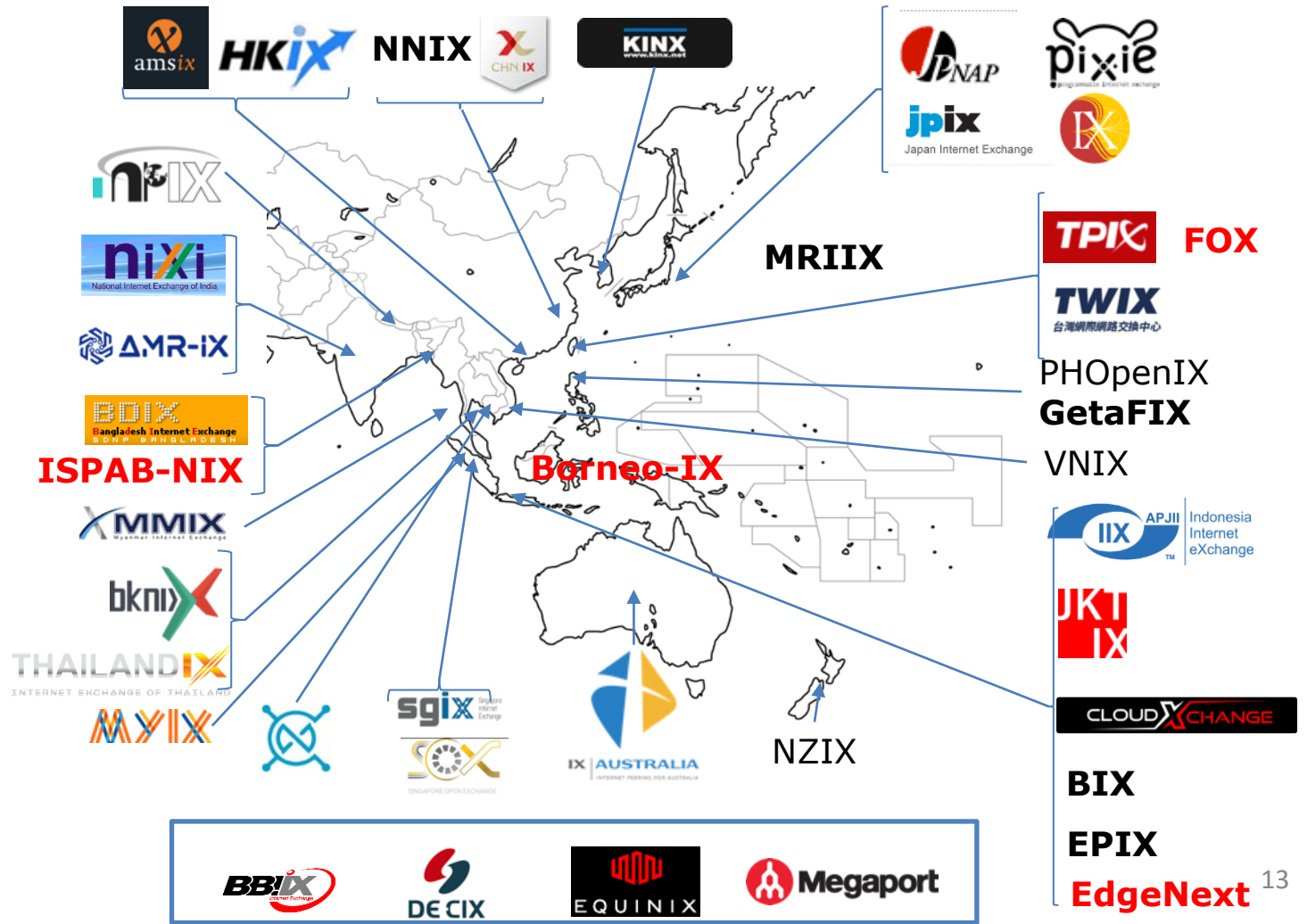

Policy change of IPv4 assignment size for IXP

- Discussion
 - Positive
 - Will save IPv4 space for future new IXPs
 - Small islands countries can save the cost for IPv4 address space (/24 costs much for them)
 - Negative
 - Renumbering by its members/customers is not so easy as people think (requires much resource)
 - For smooth migration, IXPs have to prepare and repeatedly announce in advance; route servers of the IXP have to be reconfigured
 - Its members/customers, Network side, have to prepare the reconfiguration (manually or by program)
 - If it grows more quickly than expected, IXP and members/customers have to repeat it three times (/26->/25->/24->/23)
- At the Policy WG meeting (on Thursday)
 - Comments were made by some attendees at the Workshop
 - As a result, the policy change was not accepted, but will be discussed on the mailing list

Collaboration between IXP and its members/customers

- Discussion
 - IXPs need collaboration with Content/Cloud/CDN
 - They are important to attract and increase its members/customers
 - Some Content/CDN providers have cache servers for a small/medium IXP
 - They can provide it if their criteria meets (estimated total traffic, hit-rate, etc)

Summary

- From both IXP attendees and Content/CDN/Network attendees, their reactions were positive
- In future, it will be possible to have both parts in APIX meeting; a closed part to IXP and open part to IXP members/customers

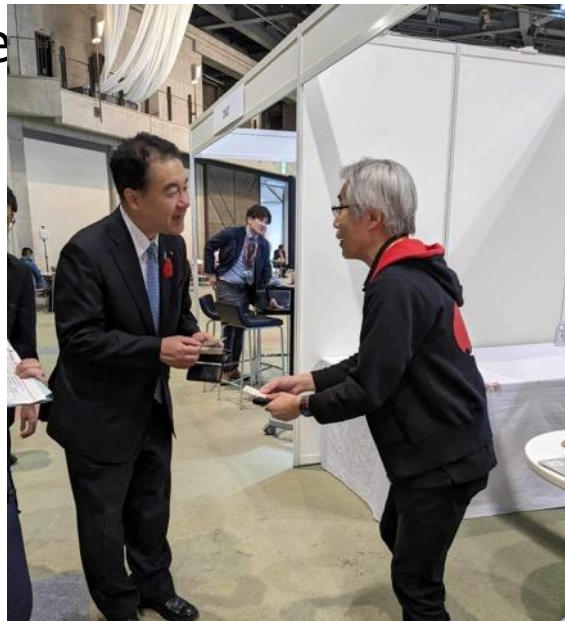
